### **OVERDUE BOOKS**

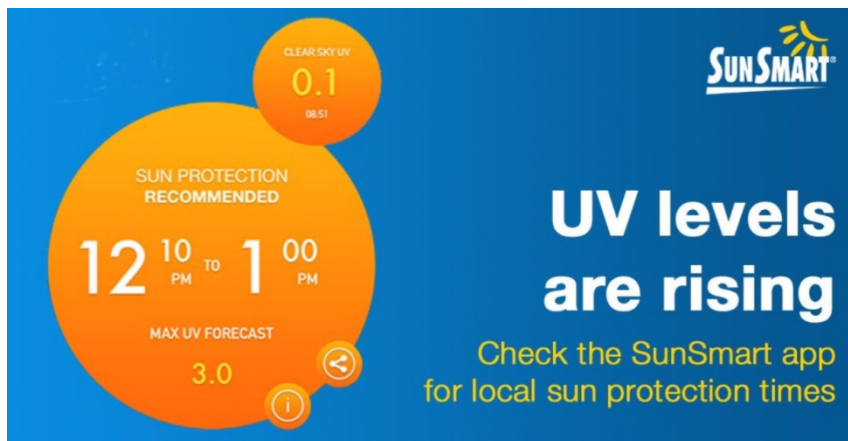
