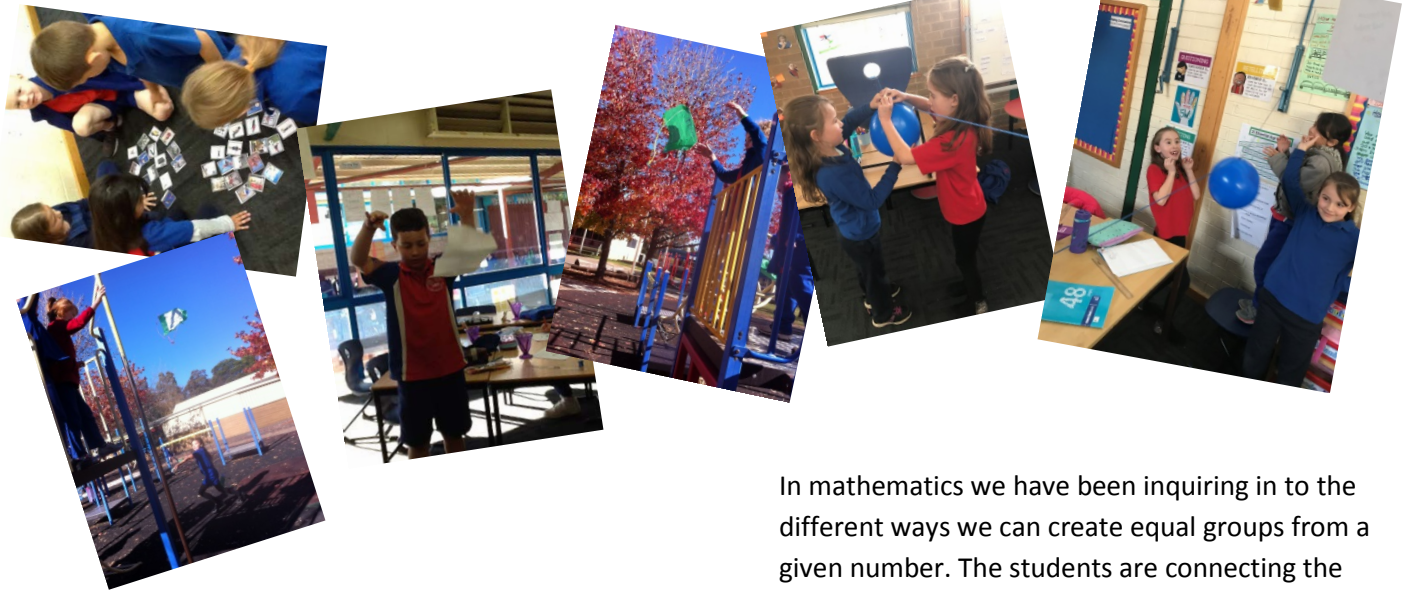

Year 2 News

In *How The World Works*, Year Two have been exploring the different forces that surround us in everyday life. So far we have had a focus on gravity, what it looks like and ways to reduce the effect. We have noticed that when an object falls with a larger surface area, the air resistance slows down the pull of gravity. We tested this theory by predicting which classroom objects would hit the ground first when dropping them at the same time. To solidify this concept the students then designed and made their own parachutes of different sizes and successfully saved their paperclip soldiers from a great deal of pain.

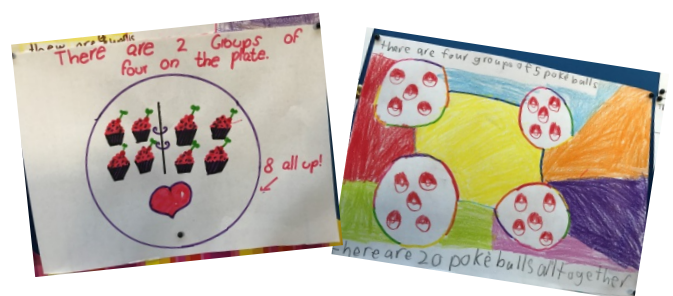
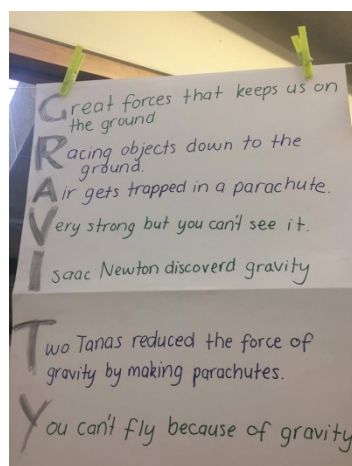
We are now looking at the forces of push and pull and the students did a fantastic job of sorting objects in to push, pull or both push and pull categories. The students then had a great time creating balloon rockets and discussed how thrust is achieved from the energy being forced out of the small area of the balloon. Next we will be focusing on friction, followed by the most exciting part — a trip to Questacon! We hope this trip will solidify their ideas and extend their understanding of the concepts we have focused on.



In mathematics we have been inquiring in to the different ways we can create equal groups from a given number. The students are connecting the concept of grouping to multiplication facts.

Soon we will be exploring mass and comparing different weights which will extend our inquiry in to Galileo's theory that weight is independent of gravitational pull.

In literacy we are having fun with quick writes that relate to our Unit such as this fantastic class collaborated GRAVITY acrostic poem. We will then look closely at how to write a procedural text, which they can then apply when creating their own experiments to finish this Unit of Inquiry.
