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Water Safety Procedure at Preschool

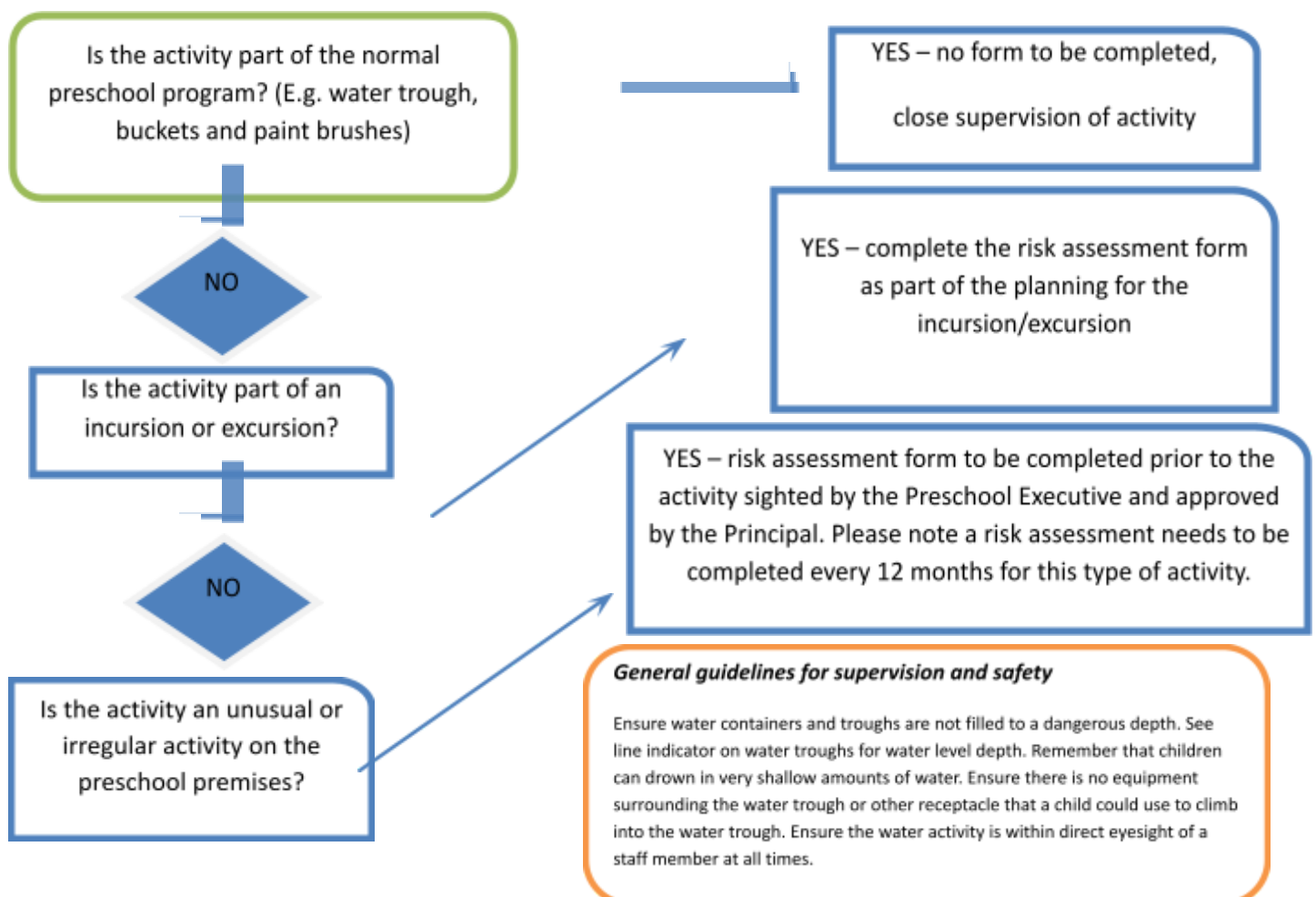
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This procedure must be read in conjunction with the ACT Education and Training Directorate's policy 'Swimming Pool and Water Based Aquatic Activities'.

Activities, excursions and incursions involving water, carry an increased risk which needs to be considered beforehand. Some specific water activities/excursions will require a risk assessment form to be completed (see flowchart below), however all water activities should incorporate the following supervision and safety guidelines. Children's safety and wellbeing will be protected in and around water through supervision and education.
