Central Idea: Respectful relationships builds belonging

Big Idea: Connection

Lines of Inquiry:

1. Exploring identity and the connections we make help us belong to groups.
2. What are responsible choices and why are they important

Unit Description:

In this unit we will be exploring our uniqueness and similarities to help create respectful and cohesive class communities. Children will share their individual stories in regards to their family as they develop their understanding of differences. Time will be spent exploring the connections we have with others. How we treat others. And how we develop our ability to make friendships, as we grow as social learners.
