



Update on Proposed boundary fence at Miles Franklin Primary School



Dear resident,

During August 2022, the Education Directorate facilitated a second round of community engagement to capture feedback on a proposed school fence at Miles Franklin Primary School. The Directorate is committed to achieving a balance between the needs of the school and wider community.

An updated fence design was proposed as part of this engagement which included:

- enhanced community access of public footpaths allowing bikes, strollers and pedestrian traffic to pass through freely
- moving the fence-line significantly away from footpaths near neighbouring residents
- gates at the basketball courts allowing community access out of school hours, and
- unrestricted access to the south-west Evatt Oval.

The majority of feedback received through this recent engagement has highlighted the support of installing a boundary fence at Miles Franklin Primary School. Requests for amendments have been considered where possible. The Directorate would like to thank everyone who participated in the community engagement process.

Procurement of the boundary fence will now commence.
