Canteen has re-opened for 2019 – order lunches via [www.flexischools.com.au](http://www.flexischools.com.au) before 8.30am. We have continued with our Monday lunch orders – please use the Monday Lunches tab in Flexischools to order. Sorry No Cash lunch orders unless your internet or Flexischools is not working but please keep trying till the 8.30am cut off.

Children can purchase snacks at the Canteen at the lunch time break. The new recess selling time is 1.20pm to 1.30pm. If you require your child to have a more substantial snack for recess this will need to be ordered in Flexischools for them to collect at 1.20pm.

We recommend that you send your child to school with coins or small notes to use at the Canteen. Large notes are difficult to provide change for and may be lost during the day. We also encourage parents to have a chat to your child that buying for friends is discouraged (whilst a lovely gesture) we need to be careful about food allergies and also what other parents might like their children eating.

\*\*\* If your child has dietary restrictions, please email or come and speak with the Canteen to ensure your child is not buying items that they are not able to eat. If you are concerned your child cannot make the right choice when buying, you can order their treat on Flexischools for them to collect at the break.

# PARKING AROUND SCHOOLS

## Enforcement around schools

### Newsletter article:

Parking Operations use a [Licence Plate Recognition vehicle](#) (or electronic chalking), which regularly patrols school environments to increase safety for children. Motorists that commit an offence will receive their infringement notice in the mail (rather than on their windscreen) 5-7 days after the offence.

While the school can become congested during the peak times, illegal parking should be avoided at all times as it creates an unsafe environment for children and local residents. Parents are welcome to park on side streets around the school, but please remember to park legally. Infringements for parking on nature strips, footpaths, verges, street corners and near children's crossings start from \$114.
